**LOST & FOUND IN NEW LOCATION:** The Lost & Found station is located on the permanent shelf in the hallway across from the family bathroom.

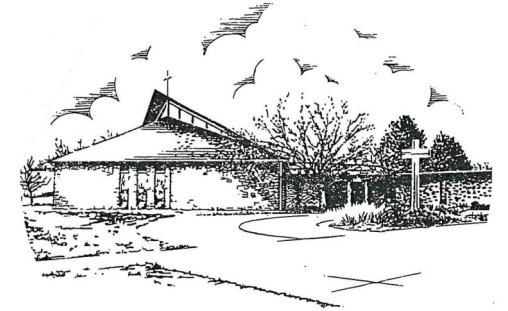
