

**CTK CARES COMMITTEE:** CTK Cares would like the congregation to vote on which organization they will assist at the October Voter's Meeting. They have narrowed it down to 3 organizations and here's a little about each one.

**1)The Homestead Ministry:** based out of Manhattan, KS

When you give to the Homestead, you help make the mission of reaching and teaching adult female survivors of sex trafficking to become more fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ. It is within this vital relationship that true healing is possible from the inside out. They run solely on donations from people just like YOU.

**2) Operation Christmas Child:** part of Samaritan's Purse Ministries

The mission of Operation Christmas Child is to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way to children in need around the world. Participants fill shoeboxes with toys, school supplies, and personal care items for children ages 2-14. Participants can select either girl or boy and an age range for the gifts. These gifts are then delivered to children in need around the world. This ministry provides both gifts as well as an accompanying gospel message to share the hope of Christ.

**3) Love, Chloe Foundation:** based out of Salina, KS

The Love, Chloe mission is to provide hope for families facing a childhood cancer diagnosis with immediate financial and family support, while raising awareness and contributing to the funding of childhood cancer research. Programs Include: Monkey in my Chair, Family Support, and DIPG Collaborative (The DIPG Collaborative is a collection of foundations with the shared mission of efficiently funding and inspiring Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG) cancer research.)
